- 1 The originating application made by **Mitchell Wayne Mansfield** of the Cayman Islands and **Jason Aleksander Kardachi**, of Singapore, both chartered accountants and accredited insolvency practitioners, on 4 December 2019, was determined by the Honourable Justice Moore on 6 December 2019.
- 2 The determination was made after a judicial telephone conference convened on 5 December 2019.
- 3 At the teleconference, Messrs McMillan and Broad appeared for the applicants, Mr Barker appeared for for DOF Management Australia Pty Limited and Mr Wass appeared for China Oil Services Limited.
- 4 The Court issued a Minute on 6 December 2019. The following orders were made:
 - a leave is granted for this application to be made on a without notice basis;
 - b the convening period for the watershed meeting be extended from Monday, 9 December 2019 to 5pm on Monday, 16 December 2019 in respect of Tamarind Taranaki Limited (Administrators Appointed) ('**Tamarind**');
 - c within 3 working days of the date of the Minute of 6 December 2019, copies of the application, supporting documents, orders, and the Minute be given to creditors of Tamarind by:
 - i email, where an email address has been provided to Tamarind; or
 - ii posted on Borrelli Walsh's website (www.borrelliwalsh.com) on the webpage in respect of the administration of Tamarind.
 - d leave is granted to any person who can demonstrate sufficient interest to apply to modify or discharge these orders, including any creditor of the applicant on notice being given to the applicants;
 - e leave is reserved to the applicants or any creditor to apply for further orders as may be necessary to give effect to the Court's orders; and
 - f the costs of this application are to be paid out of the assets of Tamarind.
