- Understanding grievance
- Gathering of facts and timeline(s)
- Escalation and de-escalation
- Friction points
- Mental health considerations
- Drugs/alcohol considerations

- "Whole Person Approach" and treating threat actors as people
- Perception vs. reality
- "Pathway to Violence"
- Red flag indicators of potential violence
- Boundary probing
- Perseveration
- Triggering events
- Stabilizing factors and de-stabilizing factors
- Ability, proximity and resources of threat actor

Intervention and Mitigation



- Well informed
- Creative use of all available resources
- Physical security considerations

Case Management



- Synchronization of multidisciplinary team
- Plan for the unexpected
